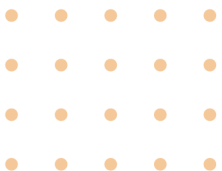

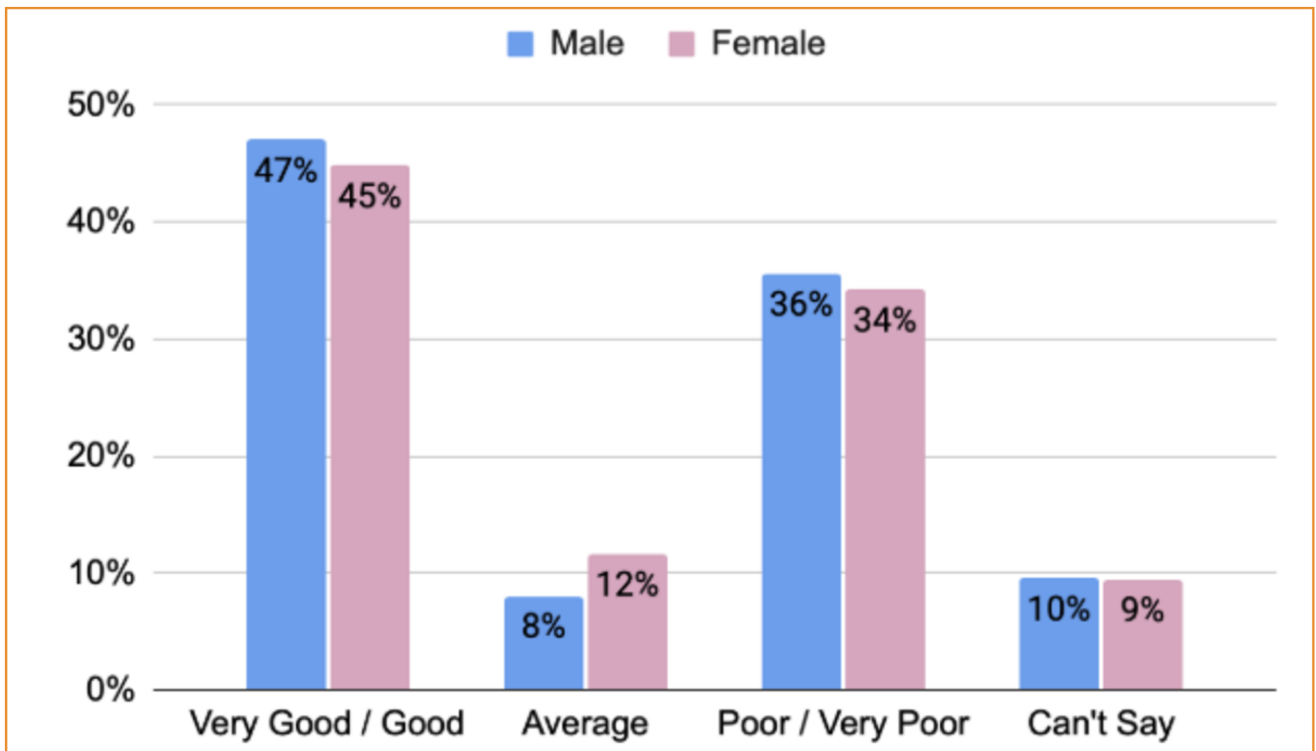




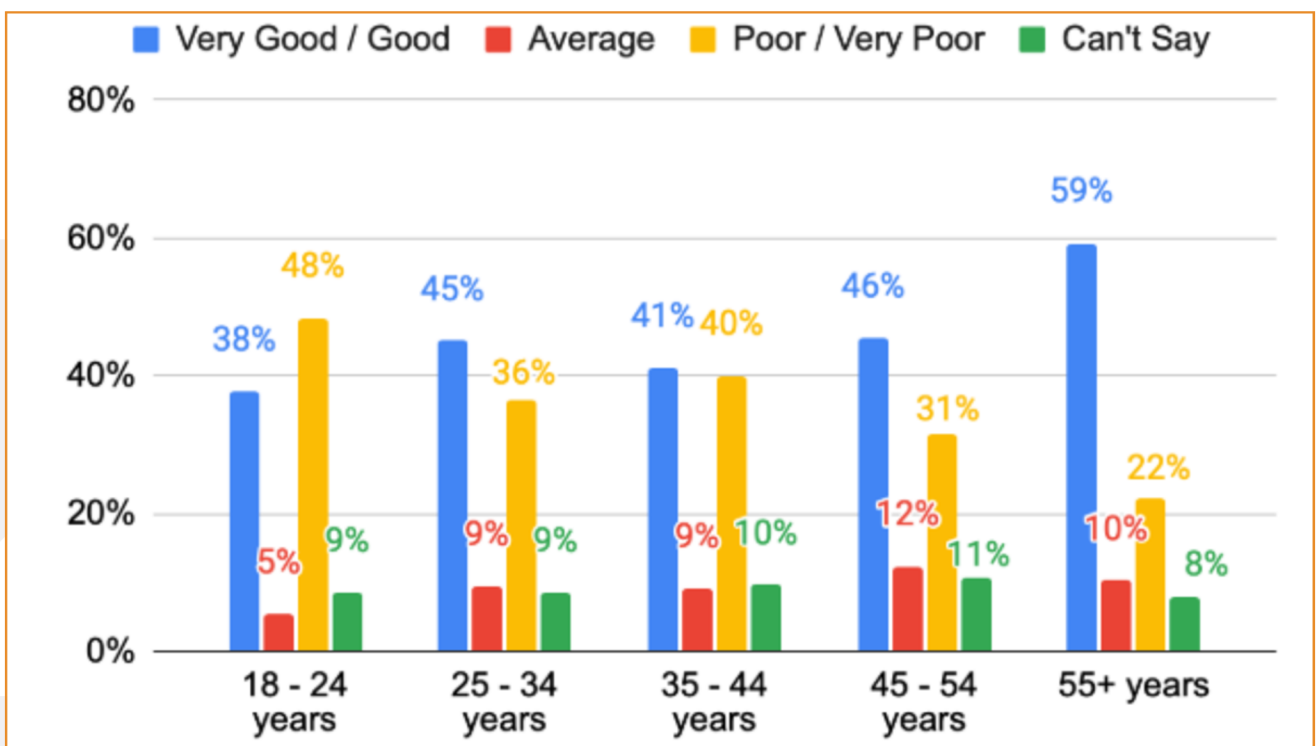
Q1: How would you rate the performance of Rekha Gupta led BJP Govt. in Delhi in its first 100 days?

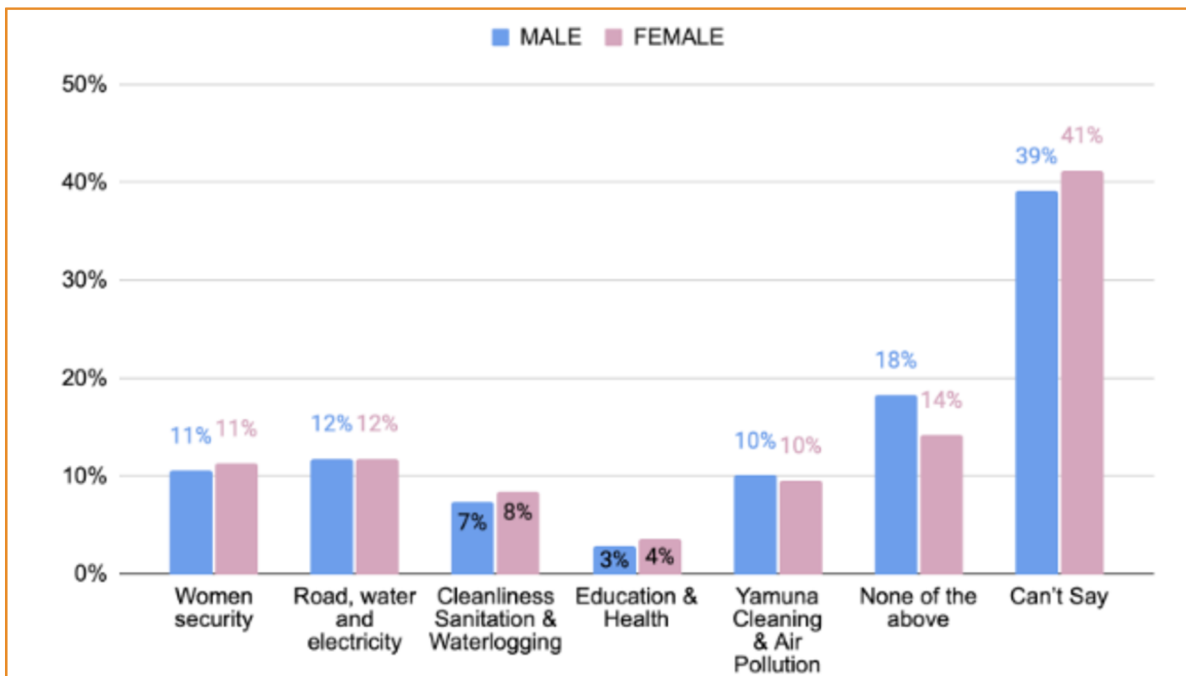

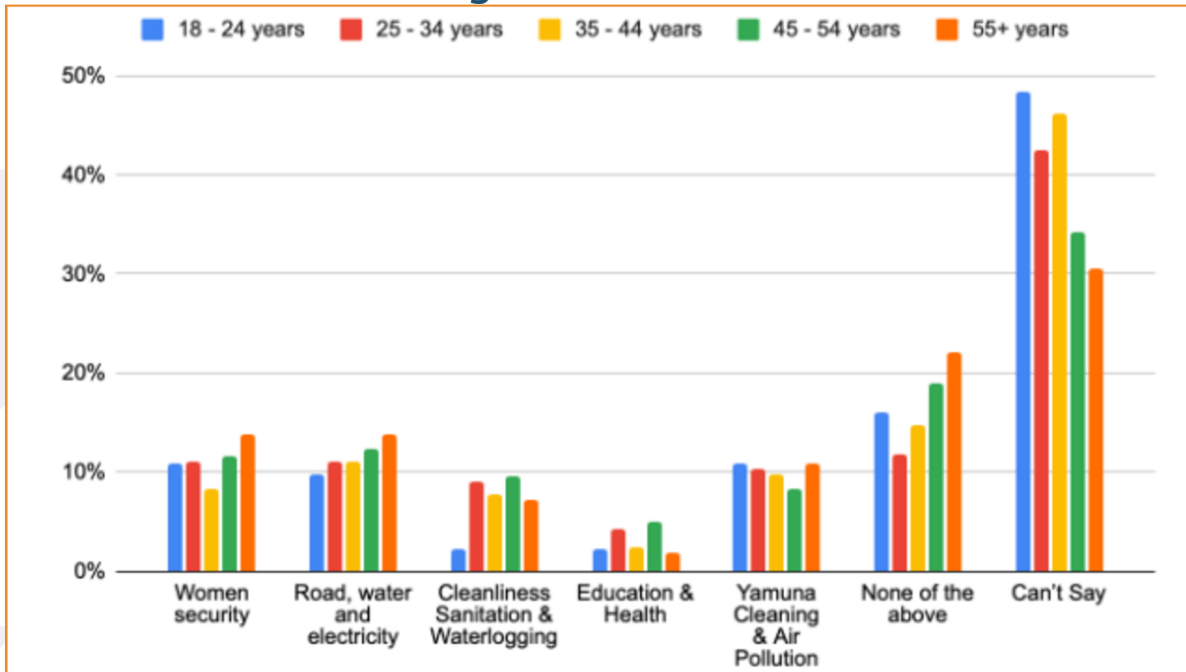
Q2: In which areas do you feel satisfied with the work done by the CM Rekha Gupta-led BJP government?

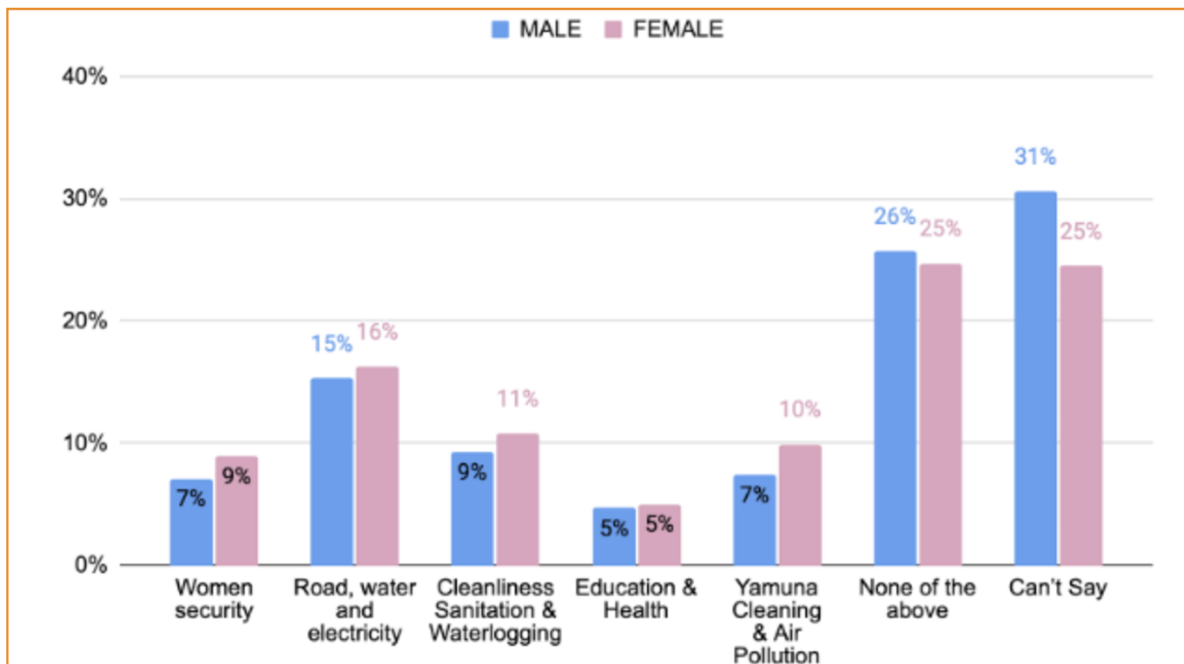

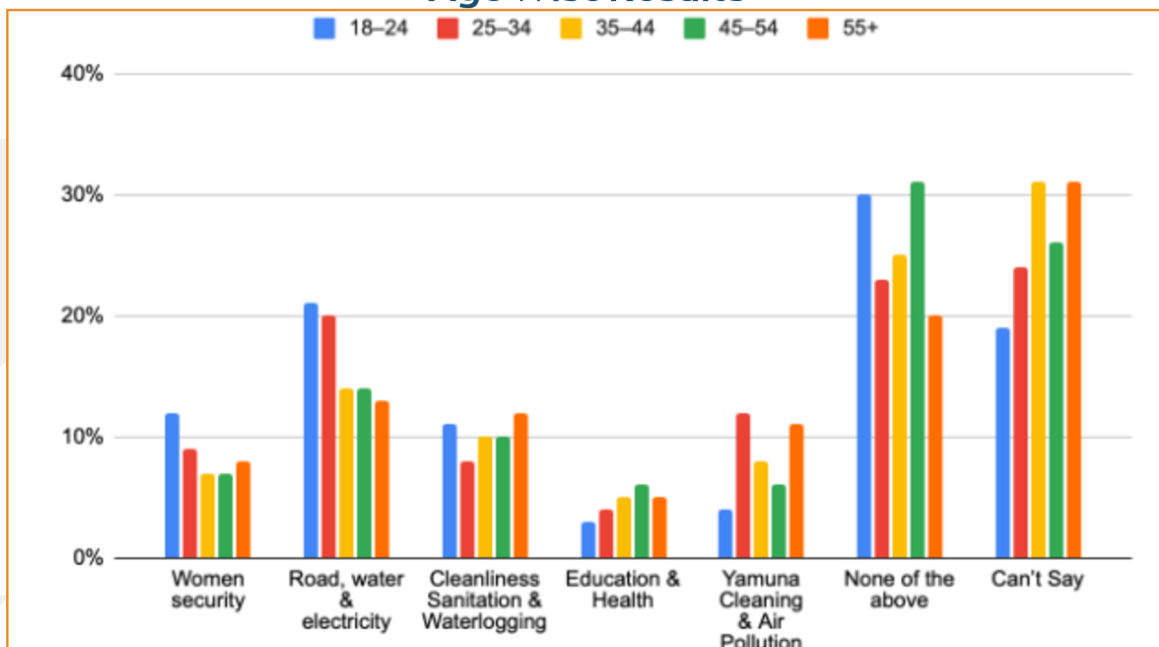
Q3: In which area do you feel dissatisfied with the work done by the CM Rekha Gupta-led BJP government?

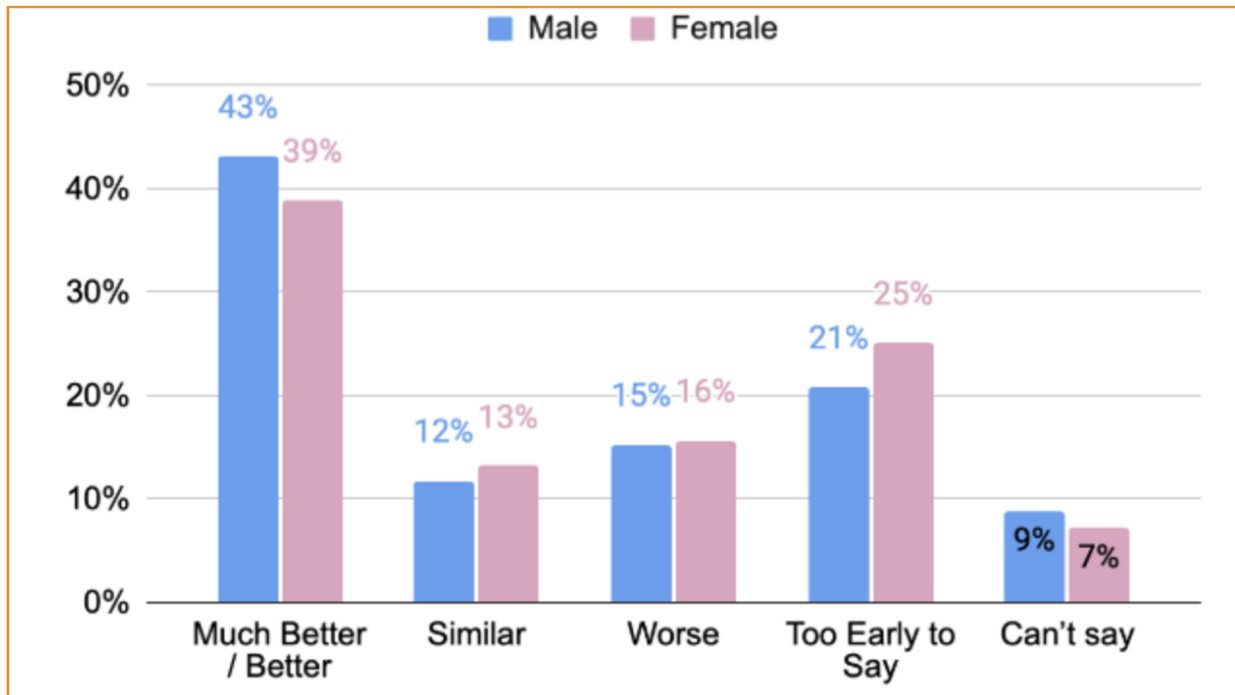

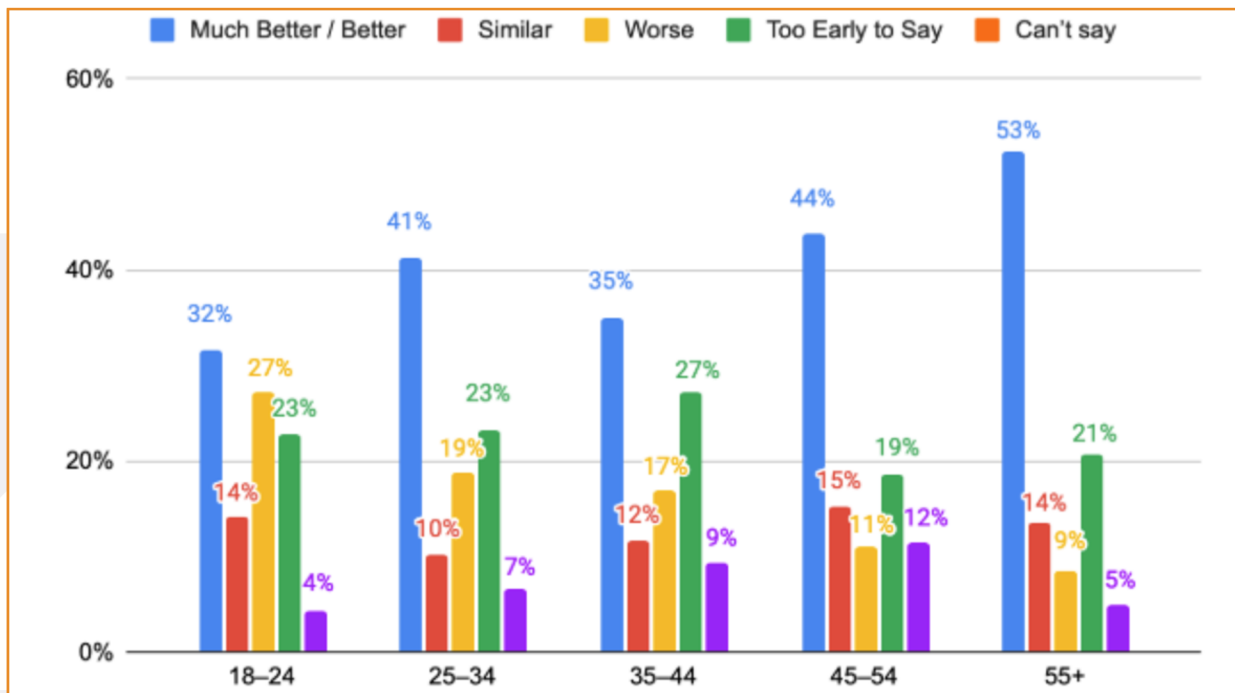
Q4: How has the Rekha Gupta-led BJP government performed in comparison to the Arvind Kejriwal-led AAP govt.?

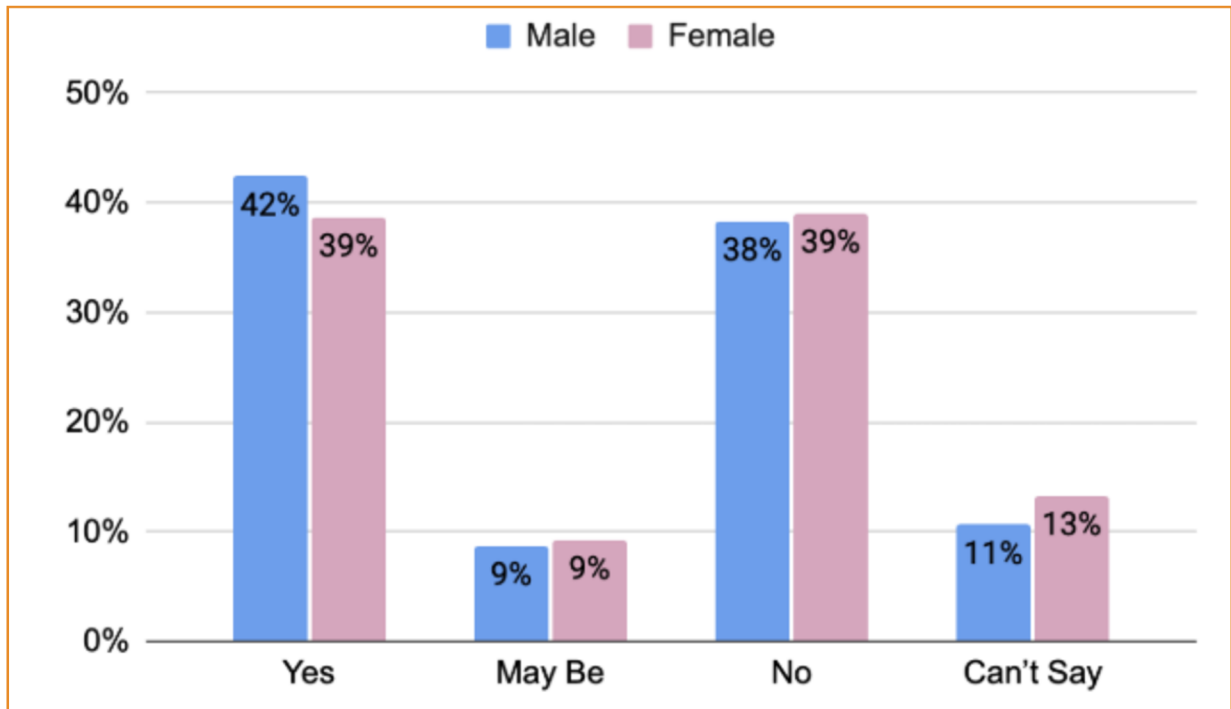




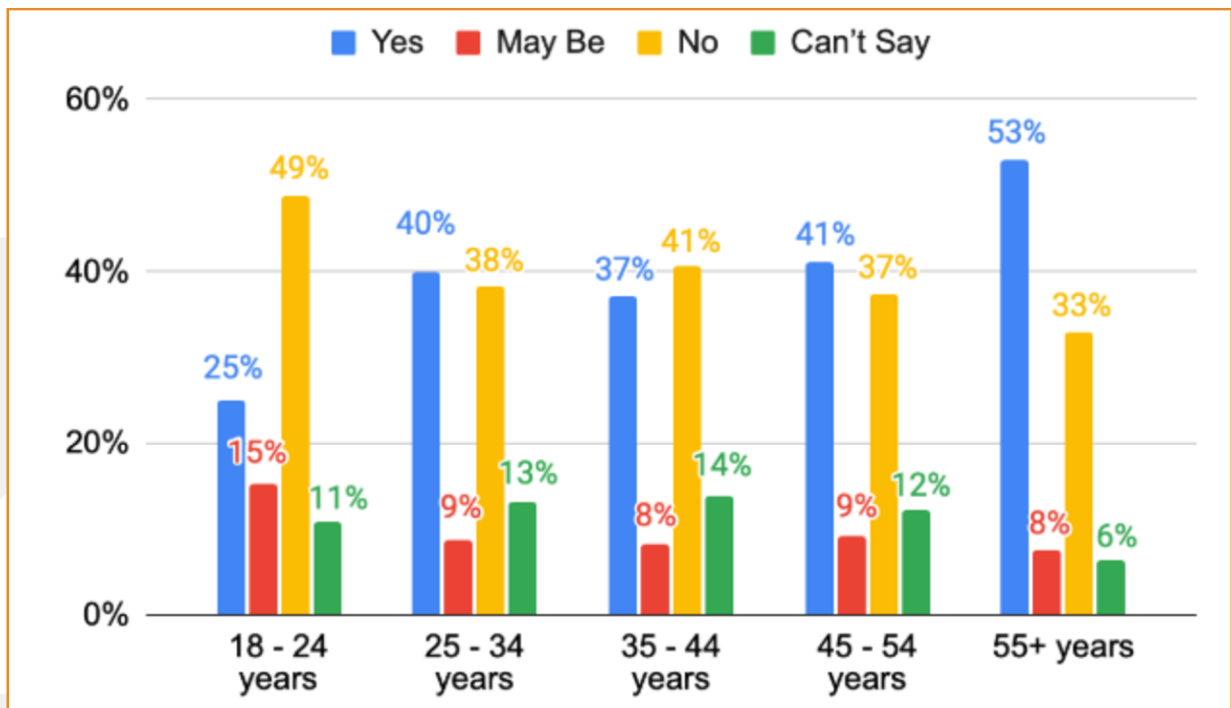
Q5: If elections were held today, would you want to see Rekha Gupta as Chief Minister?

Summary of Findings:

The data reveals interesting demographic patterns in public opinion about the 100 Days of the BJP Govt. in Delhi.

1. Overall Performance Rating:

- 46% positive rating (Very Good + Good: 34% + 12%)
- 34.8% negative rating (Poor + Very Poor: 15.8% + 19%)
- Shows a polarized public opinion with slight positive lean

2. Age-Based Patterns:

- Strong age correlation: Support increases with age
- 18-24 age group: Only 37.7% positive vs 48.4% negative
- 55+ age group: 59.3% positive vs 22.3% negative
- Younger voters are significantly more critical

3. Infrastructure as Key Issue:

- Roads, Water & Electricity is both top satisfaction (11.7%) and dissatisfaction (15.7%) area
- Indicates mixed performance in this critical sector

4. Political Competitiveness:

- Re-election preference is nearly tied: 40.6% Yes vs 38.7% No
- 41.2% say government is better than Kejriwal's vs 15.4% saying worse
- 23% say "too early to say" - a significant undecided segment

5. Areas Needing Attention:

- Education & Health shows low satisfaction (3.2%)
- 25.1% are dissatisfied with "all areas"
- High "Don't know" responses suggest communication gaps



Key Insights

Mixed Performance Rating

46% rate the government positively (Very Good + Good), while 34.8% rate it negatively (Poor + Very Poor). This indicates a polarized public opinion.

Age-Based Approval Pattern

Support increases with age: 18-24 age group shows 37.7% positive rating vs 55+ showing 59.3% positive rating. Younger voters are more critical.

Infrastructure as Top Concern

Roads, Water & Electricity is both the top satisfaction area (11.7%) and top dissatisfaction area (15.7%), showing mixed performance in this critical sector.

High Uncertainty Levels

Large portions respond 'Don't know' across questions (9-40%), suggesting either early tenure effects or lack of clear policy impact visibility.

Close Re-election Race

Re-election preference is nearly tied: 40.6% Yes vs 38.7% No, indicating a competitive political landscape.
